Please read and follow these guidelines for eligibility:

- 1. Applicant must be a <u>member</u> of Mt. Zion Baptist church <u>for at least one year</u> prior to making application and have been actively involved in a church ministry while in high school.
- 2. Applicant must have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or better.
- 3. Applicant must meet all graduating requirements, as well as having been accepted into an accredited college, junior college, university or technical school as a <u>full-time</u> student.

*Please note that this scholarship is awarded based on a point system. Ministry involvement, GPA, and essay are rated and scored to determine the amount awarded to each student.

Please submit the following required materials in one complete application package:

- 1. A completed and signed application (Includes parent's and your signature).
- 2. A typed a 400-500 word essay which should address all of the following topics:
 - (a) your educational and career goals
 - (b) how you intend to use your education to foster Christian relationships
 - (c) your church membership, church activities, organizations and positions held; and how your participation helped develop your Christian character
 - (d) where do you see yourself five (5) years from now?
- 3. A recommendation letter from a teacher, counselor or work supervisor.
- 4. At least one document that proves acceptance or enrollment from your selected college or university. (Examples include: admissions acceptance letter, proof of tuition deposit, or proof of class registration.)
- 5. A clear, clean and appropriate individual **photo** of yourself.
- 6. An **OFFICIAL school transcript** (unofficial or opened transcripts will not be accepted) showing your recent cumulative grade point average should be sent to:
